- Do Not Apply with Rain Forecast
- Works in Cooler Temps
- Use Between 45°-80°
- Apply to Wet Lawn

Homogenized Formulation

- This process makes Nitrogen (gas) stable so it can be used by the plant without evaporating.
- This process makes Phosphate (P) and Potassium (K) readily available to the plant
- Homogenized fertilizer will feed your lawn for 90 days (non-homogenized feed for up to 30 days)

Why Liming is Important

- A balanced pH is vital to a healthy lawn!
- The availability of fertilizer nutrients is dependent on the pH, a measurement of acidity or alkalinity. If it is too high or too low the nutrients may be locked up and not available to plants.

Lime to a pH of 6.0 - 7.0, or 1 bag (40 lb) per 1,000 sq ft

Tip: Use a broadcast spreader for even distribution of seed, fertilizer, and lime.
